

OVERVIEW

- ▶ In 2019 the printing and paper industry accounted for about 1.2% of GDP. At the beginning of 2021 the industry has employed around 9.0 thousand workers or 0.9% of total employment.
- ▶ 422 enterprises were active in the industry at the beginning of 2021 and 99% of them were small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) with 1-249 persons employed.

- ▶ In 2019 industrial production of printing and paper industry products amounted to 0.9 billion EUR, which was 7.3% more than in 2018.

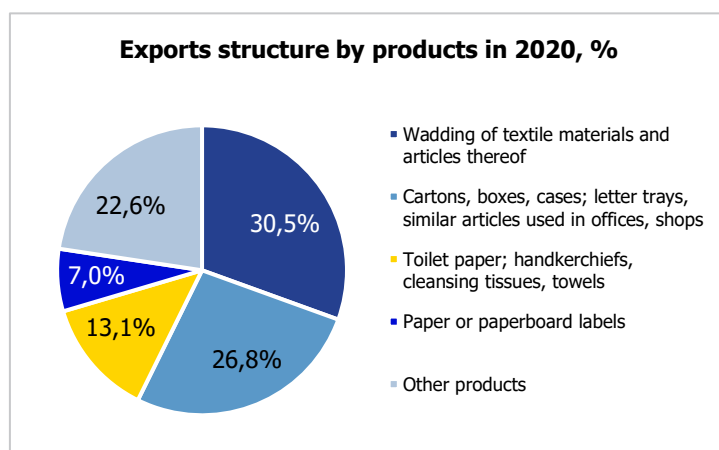
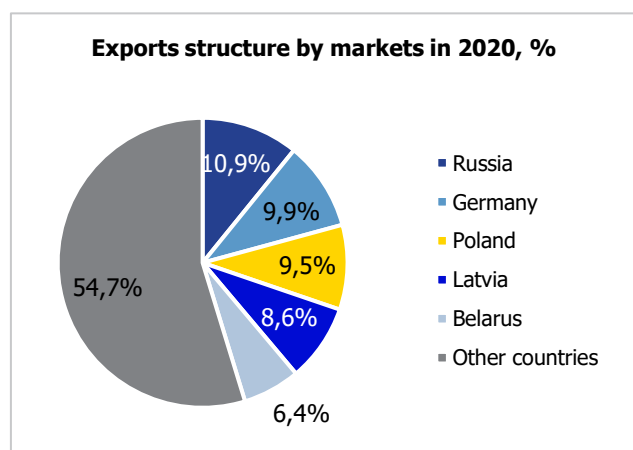
- ▶ In 2020 exports of domestically produced printing and paper industry products decreased by 3.3% or 11 million EUR and amounted to 333 million EUR. In 2020 exports of domestically produced goods consisted mainly of wadding (31%), cartons, boxes and other products of paper or paperboard (27%), sanitary goods (13%) and paper and paperboard labels (7.0%). The decrease in printing and paper production exports in 2020 was mainly driven by the exports of wadding products – the exports value decreased by 10 million EUR (or 9.0%) to 102 million EUR. Whereas the largest increase in exports in 2020 was recorded for sanitary goods – exports value increased by 20% (or 7.4 million EUR) to 44 million EUR.

- ▶ In 2020 the most important export markets for the printing and paper industry were Russia (11%), Germany (9.9%), Poland (9.5%) and Latvia (8.6%). Countries in the European Union accounted for 61% of exports by the printing and paper products industry in 2020. The exports of printing and paper industry products in 2020 has decreased most significantly to Russia – exports value decreased by 19 million EUR or 35% to 36 million EUR.
